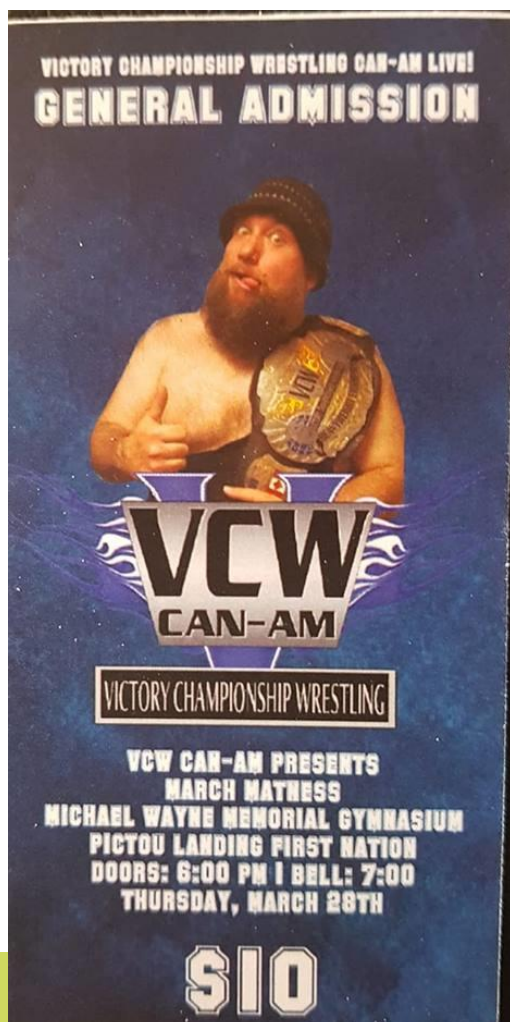

## Notice from PLFN Fire Department

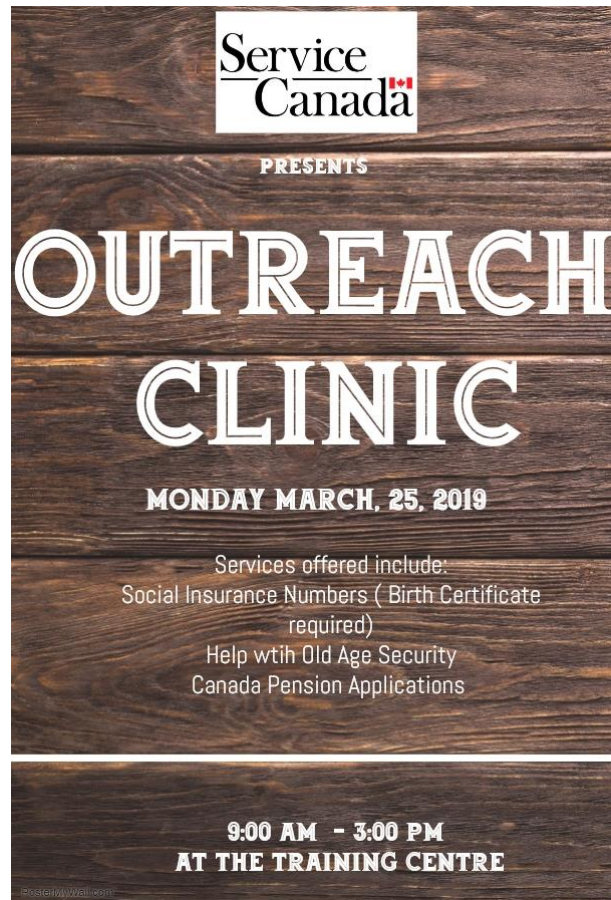
### Notice from PLFN Fire Department:

**Position: Committee Coordinator**

**Term Contract Position:** starts April 15, 2019 *term position (approx. 6 months)*

**Position Description:** The Committee Coordinator is a key part of the future of PLFN's structured committees supported with the development of the policies and the governance framework of PLFN.

### **Responsibilities:**

- To research existing formulated committees within the industry to obtain current structures and functionality of other first nation or municipal committees
- To review, analyse, and recommend revisions to existing policies and procedures including monetary benefits regarding committees currently at PLFN
- To present finding to Band Administration. Responsible to The Director of Communications.
- Establish a manual for PL Band outlining suggested committees with types of committees, terms of reference, including all supporting materials with definitions, structure and capacity.
- Work to assist with the administration committee to over see the establishment and governance (this may vary based on individual committee needs).
- To oversee a future committee engagement within the community
- Assess the usefulness and effectiveness of existing committees within PLFN
- Determine the linkage of community committees and PL Administration in relation to the programs and services under the authority of the Band.

**Position Description:** The Fishing Captain reports to the Director of Fishery. The captain supervises and supply purchases. Captains must also be familiar with navigation and sonar technology, GPS systems, so they can safely navigate the ship to its destined location and avoid any hazards. Captains are also responsible for keeping daily records onboard the ship by maintaining what is known as a ship's log.
