

## Dr. Piet LEROY – MAASTRICHT (NL)



Piet Leroy (Belgium 1969), MD, PhD, MSc is a senior consultant in paediatric critical care and director of the Paediatric Procedural Sedation Unit at Maastricht University Medical Centre ([www.mumc.nl](http://www.mumc.nl)), Maastricht, The Netherlands. He is an associate professor (domain of medical teaching) at the Faculty of Health, Life Sciences and medicine at Maastricht University ([www.maastrichtuniversity.nl](http://www.maastrichtuniversity.nl)) and graduated in 2017 as a Master in Health Professions Education at the Maastricht

School of Health Professions Education.

His main research topics concern delirium in critical care and procedural sedation in children. Within these fields he has published over 50 scientific papers, guidelines and book chapters. In 2013 he received the Catharina Pijls Prize for his research on the improvement of procedural sedation quality in paediatrics. He is a board member of the International Committee for the Advancement of Procedural Sedation ([www.proceduralsedation.org](http://www.proceduralsedation.org)) and editor for the European Journal of Pediatrics.
