

Dr. Cyril SAHYOUN – GENEVA (CH)



Cyril Sahyoun is an attending physician at the Children's Hospital of Geneva. He attended medical school at Georgetown University, Residency at Columbia Presbyterian and Fellowship at Boston Children's Hospital, where he developed clinical expertise in procedural sedation, anxiolysis and analgesia. After returning as an attending physician at his alma mater in NYC to head Medical Student Education efforts in the Pediatric Emergency Department, Cyril Sahyoun moved to Switzerland, where he is helping boost the field of Pediatric Emergency Medicine. Cyril has authored an influential review article and book chapter in the field of sedation, and is the co-editor of a multidisciplinary thematic series of papers on pediatric procedural sedation for the European

Journal of Pediatrics chaired by Piet Leroy. Cyril is currently working on setting up the first European Database on PSA. Other academic interests include medical trainee education in analgesia and anxiolysis, communication in the clinical environment as well as prehospital care. His other jobs include baking sourdough breads, and trying to be a good father to his 2 year old son Christian and a good husband to his super pregnant wife.
