

**Dr. Silvia BRESSAN – PADOVA (Italy)**



Silvia Bressan is a consultant in Pediatric Emergency Medicine and Assistant professor of Pediatrics at the University of Padova, in Italy. She trained in Italy, Israel and Australia. She did her PhD on the management of paediatric head injuries in the emergency setting between Italy and Australia. Her main areas of clinical and research interest are trauma, fever and paediatric sedation and analgesia (PSA). With respect to the PSA field she has been mentored by prof Baruch Krauss (Harvard Medical School, Boston, USA); prof Itai Shavit, (Rambam Healthcare Campus, Haifa, Israel); prof Franz Babl (The Royal Children's Hospital, Melbourne, Australia), and prof Dino Barbi (Universita' di Trieste, Italy). 2017, she was part of the scientific committee of the Italian national consensus conference on paediatric PSA in the emergency department. She is also part of the faculty of the paediatric PSA course (which includes simulation based scenarios) that is held twice a year at Meyer Children's Hospital, Florence, Italy. She is engaged in the implementation of PSA in the paediatric emergency department of her institution. Silvia Bressan is an author in 60 publications in international peer reviewed journals.
